



Robin's Ruler Pouch - Great starter project!

Make this handy pouch to hold either the Skinny or Fat Robin Ruler/Book Combo and all of your other Robin Ruth Design ruler, books. and patterns! Each bag folds over at the top and is made with a fat quarter, four strips, and a square of fabric. Make a pouch to help keep any project you are working on all in one place!



Construction Instructions


Make either the 8" Skinny Robin or Fat Robin Mariner's Compass blocks following the instructions in the corresponding Skinny Robin or Fat Robin 16-Point Mariner's Compass Book. Follow the instructions in Step 31, Page 13 in the Mariner's Compass Chapter, to prepare your block for a reverse appliqué center. Finish the center by placing the Center square of fabric on the underside of the block and then top stitch around the square that was created in to block. Prepare the 8" block for appliqué using an 8" freezer paper circle and following the instructions in the Finishing Chapter, Page 7, of your instruction book.


Rotate blocks for a different look!







2 Place prepared block on right side of 18"x22" fat quarter. Position it so that it is 2¾" from the bottom right raw edge and 1%" away from the right side raw edge as illustrated below. Appliqué or top stitch the compass block onto the fat quarter.





3 Fold the fat quarter with right sides together matching together the 18" raw edges. Sew around the side and bottom using a ¹/₄" seam.





Turn bag right side out. Press top edge under ¼" and then ¼" again. Topstitch around the top a scant ¼". Ruler bag can be folded over and pinned, or you can add a loop to the top finished edge and sew on a button where you want it to close.
