About $1 / 2$ yd. PWSL088.BLUE Padma Placement for block centers shown above. Numbers and letters refer to block numbers and letters in the cutting instructions.


Fussy cut four equal borders out of a $2^{11 / 2} y$ d. length of fabric. If using PWSL084.BLACK Ming Embroidery fabric, they will end up being a little over 71/4" wide. These border strips will be longer than you need, but will allow for extra room to center the flower patterns on each side and also to miter the corners.

## Construction

I have posted some video tutorials for making an 18" block for this quilt on Instagram and Facebook. You should be able to look me up - Robin Ruth Design - on either platform and be able to watch all the videos. I also have full video tutorials for every block in my system under the Video Tutorials tab on my website.
(1) Make the ten Skinny Robin 16-point 18", 20", 22", and 24 " Compass blocks following the instructions starting on Page 4 of the Mariner's Compass chapter of my Skinny Robin 16-Point Book. Add the centers using the Faced Circle Center method on Page 4 of the Finishing Chapter in the Skinny Robin 16-Point Book. Prepare all ten blocks for appliqué following the instructions on Page 7 of the Finishing Chapter in the Skinny Robin 16-Point Book using the template sheet that comes with your book and ruler to make the freezer paper circles.

(2) Make the 12" Block A and 14" Block B using the same method you did above for making faced circle centers and preparing the raw compass blocks for appliqué following the instructions in the Finishing Chapter of the Skinny Robin 16-Point Book. Cut your fabric at least 1" larger than the the finished 12 " and 14 " circles so that you will be able to prepare them for appliqué. Use the center sizes from the template sheet that correspond with the 12 " and 14 " compass blocks.

(3) Piece the Background fabric together and trim to $601 / 2 " \times 601 / 2$ ".

Sew rectangles together to make square.

(4) a) Arrange all of the blocks onto the Background until you are happy. Do not pin yet. Take a picture to refer back to.
b) Take blocks off except for the three illustrated. Pin these three blocks down and appliqué onto Background in the order shown.
c, d, e) Continue adding, pinning and appliquéing blocks down in order shown.
f) Pin and appliqué final two blocks. Trim all blocks flush with the edge of the Background. Straight stitch close to the edge around the entire perimeter of the pieced background unit to help keep the edges from stretching.

(5) Carefully cut out the Background fabric from behind the compasses and Blocks A and B, leaving 3"-4" of Background fabric around the perimeter to help keep the pieced background unit stable.

(6) a) Sew the inside border strips together into pairs to create four Inside Borders.
b) Center and sew Inside Borders to Outside Borders as illustrated below.

7 Center and sew the pieced Borders onto the pieced background unit as illustrated on Page 1 of this pattern, stopping stitching $1 / 4 "$ from the corners to enable making mitered corners. After all four Borders are sewn on, miter the corners. Quilt, bind, and finish as desired.

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
