


Made using the Small Project 14" Skinny Robin or Fat Robin Compass Sunflower block.

Construction

1 Make the Skinny Robin OR Fat Robin 16-point 14" Compass Sunflower Block following the instructions starting on Page 2 in the Companion Compass (2nd) chapter of my Skinny Robin or Fat Robin 16-Point Book. Note: Strips are cut for a 14" OctaCompass Sunflower from Page 4 of the OctaCompass (4th) chapter of your Skinny Robin or Fat Robin Book for an OctaCompass Sunflower. Center finished using the reverse appliqué technique.




2 Make a 15¹/₂" freezer paper circle template following the instructions in the Finishing (3rd) chapter on Page 2. Center the freezer paper template on your block with the template N, S, E, and W folds lined up on the block N, S, E, and W points, and press into place. Trim block flush with the freezer paper template.



B Measure up 2¹/₄" from the center bottom of the block and trim off perpendicular (90°) to the N and S points.





Use your trimmed block for the pattern to cut out the lining fabric for your wallet. Sew your block and lining together with right sides together using ¼" seam and leaving open on the bottom straight edge for later turning.
Sew with ¼" seam leaving



• Turn block and lining right side out, pushing finished edge out all the way to the seam. Press block from the back, slightly pulling the lining toward the back and making sure the lining won't show on the front. Turn under edges ¹/₄" at opening, and then edgestitch around entire perimeter of block.



6 Fold the block sides inside to the lining side so that they meet in the middle and sides are 7½" apart. Edgestitch along the folded edges. Fold the bottom up 4¼" and edgestitch again (over top of previous edgestitching) along the 4¼" folded side edges.
